

Murdoch University WACA International Cricket Academy 2021

Terms and Conditions

1. The Murdoch University WACA International Cricket Academy 2021 (ICA) is offered by Murdoch University (**Murdoch** or **University**) of 90 South Street, Murdoch, Western Australia and the Western Australian Cricket Association (**WACA**) of WACA Ground, PO Box 6045, East Perth, Western Australia.
2. The WACA will facilitate and deliver the ICA training program in agreement with Murdoch.
3. The ICA will commence from Semester 1, 22 March 2021, and will be on offer until Semester 1, 2021 end on 24 May 2021.
4. By entering the ICA, Applicants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.

Terms and Conditions for Entry

5. To enter the ICA, Applicants are required to provide the following to Murdoch before 4pm on Monday 22nd February 2021:
 - a. An application via the ICA webpage <https://murdoch.edu.au/cricketacademy>
6. Applicant(s) will only be eligible to the ICA if the Applicant(s) satisfies the following requirements:
 - a. The Applicant has received an unconditional letter of offer from Murdoch to enrol in a Murdoch coursework course;
 - b. The Applicant satisfies all Murdoch entry conditions to enrol in the Murdoch course;
 - c. The Applicant is classified as a Murdoch student and has paid their fees to Murdoch in full for their respective course;
 - d. If the Student is an international student, the Student has been granted an Australian student visa pursuant to the *Migration Act* 1958 (Cth); and
 - e. The Applicant will be commencing their studies at one of Murdoch's Western Australian campuses in 2021.
7. Following the Applicant completing the digital application pursuant to clause 5, the Applicant will be required to provide personal details including name, email address and telephone number.
8. Murdoch is not liable for late, lost or misdirected entries.
9. Current Murdoch domestic students, international students and study abroad students are eligible for the ICA.
10. Entry to the ICA is free, however successful applicants must pay an ICA fee for the program.
11. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the ICA, including but not limited to mobile telephone charges.
12. By entering the ICA, the Applicant agrees that they are over the age of 18 years, or if under the age of 18 years, have their parent's or legal guardian's consent to enter the ICA.
13. WACA will notify Applicants in writing if they have received admission into the ICA.
14. Murdoch and the WACA reserve their rights to decline to award an ICA placement to an Applicant if, in its opinion, there are no suitable applicants.
15. The number of ICA's placements awarded shall be at the sole discretion of Murdoch and the WACA.

The ICA Benefits

16. Recipients of the ICA will receive the following benefits (**Benefits**):
 - a. 10 week training program facilitated and organised by the WACA which will entail either:
 - i. Two group coaching sessions per week with WACA coaches; or
 - ii. One, one on one coaching session tailored to the Applicant's skill level and cricket goals per week.
 - b. Access to training facilities located at Murdoch's Perth Campus.
 - c. Training kit, an ICA branded uniform including a playing kit and an extra training shirt.
 - d. 1 x guided tour of the WACA grounds.

Personal Data Use and Collection

17. Murdoch will not use the Applicant's personal information for any other purpose than as stated in these Terms and Conditions without their consent unless required or authorised to do so by law. 18. Murdoch and the WACA's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Murdoch and the WACA (and its related entities, employees, contractors, servants or agents) shall not be liable for and accept no responsibility for any accident, loss, injury or damage to any individual or property arising out of any act or omission, whether negligent or otherwise in conjunction with the ICA or the Benefits, occurring either during or after the term of the ICA.
20. Participation in the ICA constitutes the Applicant's unconditional agreement to and acceptance of the Terms and Conditions.
21. The Applicant is responsible for ensuring his or her familiarity with these Terms and Conditions.
22. Murdoch and/or the WACA's decision not to enforce a specific restriction does not constitute a waiver of that restriction or of the Terms and Conditions generally.
